Sophomore artist, Soo Bin Oh was one of two recipients of the South Shore Arts Regional Award for Young Artists. The title of her mixed media work is *The Boundary of Time*. Ryan Su, a senior, earned a Merit Award for his graphite on paper work, *Inverse Vertex with Spatial De-integration*.
